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
Regulated Qualifications.

To gain your level 5 Diploma you will be required to submit product evidence such as lesson plans and resources along with your assessments.

There is a requirement to have a log of at least 100 hours teaching practice in a real classroom by the end of this qualification. The teaching hours log must be signed by a competent person in your organisation or witness to confirm the log is a true reflection of your teaching.

There is a requirement to be observed eight times delivering teaching to adults in groups of at least 5 people. This must be observed by an expert witness qualified to level 5 or equivalent in education and training. We provide the observation paperwork for them to complete which helps to record the required evidence.
